The Art of Connection

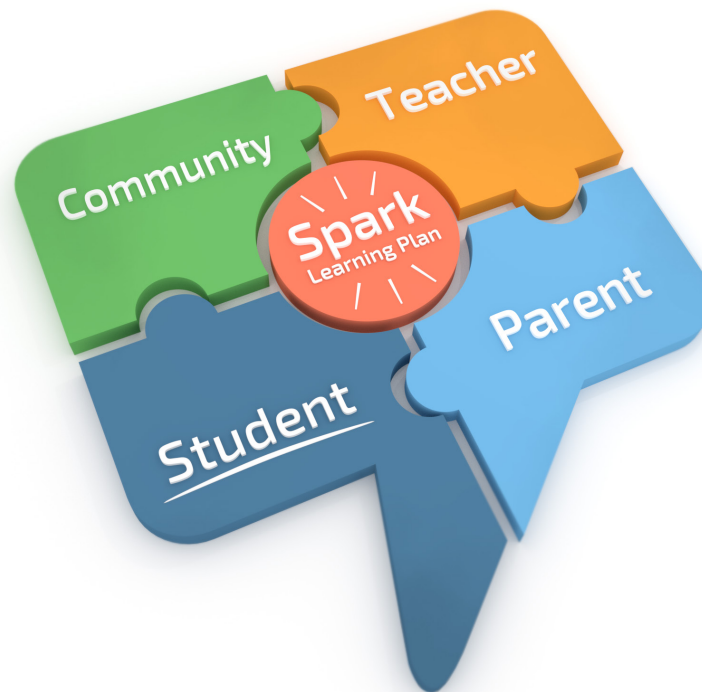

Creative Approaches to Learning

Navigate is a leader in implementing the new BC curriculum and we've taken an innovative approach to the FAE program's content, implementation, and delivery. Student work includes daily numeracy and literacy as well as music, art, drama, dance, and digital art. Thematic learning cycles involve students and community in multi-age groupings. During each cycle, students complete individual and collaborative projects relating to the theme. Each cycle concludes with a showcase day where students present their projects to classmates, parents and teachers. A compass day provides a time for parents and teachers to review progress, and plan for the next cycle.
