## **Code of Conduct**

At Navigate/NIDES we strive to provide a safe and caring environment for all learners in all environments.

Demonstrating positive conduct is the shared responsibility of students, staff, parents/guardians and the broader community at any school or school related activity and at any location, including online.

- misuse of cyberspace, cell phones, electronic devices, computers students are to be aware that misuse of technology may be subject to discipline and/or confiscation of personal property;
- interfering with the learning and working of others;
- unsafe or illegal behavior including use or possession of intoxicating, banned or controlled substances (alcohol, drugs, vaporizers, or tobacco in any form).

Consequences of unacceptable behavior will consider the student's age and maturity as well as severity and frequency of actions. Whenever possible, the focus will be on restorative action.

- 6. **Avoid Spamming**: Refrain from posting repetitive or irrelevant messages. This can be annoying and disrupt the flow of communication.
